Plan for one and a half hour Brownie meeting:

Time	Activity	Resources
15 minutes	Download a simple template from the internet and print on card. On arrival, in Sixes get the Brownies to cut out their Crown or Tiara. They can also colour in and decorate. You could also cut out some Medal shapes for the Royal 'Men'	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Crown/tiara/medal template downloaded.</li> <li>• White card.</li> <li>• Colouring crayons.</li> <li>• Decorations</li> <li>• Scissors</li> <li>• Glue</li> </ul>
10 minutes	Brownie Welcome. In Brownie Pow-wow pass around pictures of the Royal family (you will need to have one picture for each Brownie). Leader led discussion around who is on the pictures. Challenge the Brownies to see if anyone recognises any of the Royal family members. Identify them all by the end of the Pow-wow.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pictures of Royal family (you could laminate these for future use/games, have names on separate cards etc). You can decide how many members you wish to include. The list below is a guideline.</li> <li>• HM The Queen</li> <li>• HRH The Duke of Edinburgh (Phillip)</li> <li>• HRH The Prince of Wales (Charles)</li> <li>• HRH The Duchess of Cornwall (Camilla)</li> </ul>

5 minutes	<p>Explain what a family tree is and make a giant one on the floor with the pictures. Each Brownie to bring a picture up and place it on the family tree as the Leader explains how each member of the family is related. For example: “The Queen is Harry’s Grandmother” etc.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As above.</li> </ul>
20 minutes	<p>In Sixes Brownies to complete their own family tree using the simple tree picture provided. Each group could have a Leader, Unit Helper, Young Leader or Brownie Helper working with them. This activity focuses on the ‘You’ area of the Brownie Adventure Programme</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Family tree pictures.</li> </ul>

15 minutes	Drinks break - get the Brownies to choose a suitable 'Royal Cocktail' from fruits and juices on offer. Once prepared sit in groups to have drinks. Wear crowns and tiaras!	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fruit juices, squash, lemonade</li> <li>• Apple, pears, cut up small for fruit cocktails</li> <li>• Clear plastic glasses to serve drinks</li> <li>• Straws and cocktail style decorations for drinks.</li> </ul>
15 minutes	Becoming Royalty - drama activity. Get the Brownies to create a short scene to show the Royal Family at a party. They can select pictures from the match up game to hold during the drama or to remind them of their character. They should try and demonstrate that they understand who is related to whom during the drama scene. They should rehearse how they arrive at the party and act out a scenario. Remind the Brownies about some Royal etiquette for example not shaking hands with the Queen unless she offers to do so and practise those bows and curtsy!	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tiaras/Crowns/Medals made earlier</li> <li>• Royal Family style music in background!</li> </ul>
	<b>Extra activity or alternative to drama activity.</b> Play Royal Family Match Up: All Brownies take a card with a picture of a member of the Royal family. Run around swapping the cards with as many Brownies as possible until the Leader calls out 'Match your picture!' Brownies then need to shout for others with the matching picture to theirs or hold up their picture if they are unsure who it is. The last Rainbows to get into their matching group are out! (Leader can decide if this means they sit out or continue to play the game!)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pictures of the Royal family - at least 3 of each person. (Make enough for your group of Brownies).</li> </ul>
5 minutes	Close your meeting how you would normally, making sure to hand out your Royal Baby badges (Charlotte, George or both!)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Royal Baby badges available from Coventry Guide Shop.</li> </ul>
